# VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

## WORSHIP Circle the liturgical ministries you are interested in.

**Liturgy Committee** The Liturgy Committee represents the consensus of the community in matters relating to its liturgical life by planning and evaluating liturgies using the guidelines of church teaching and traditions in order to promote full, conscious and active participation.

**Minister of the Word** Confirmed & trained members of the parish who proclaim the Word of God and commentate at Liturgy.

**Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion** Confirmed and trained members of the parish who assist the ordinary minister in distributing the Body & Blood of Christ at liturgy and may bring communion to the homebound.

**Sacristan** Confirmed and trained members of the parish who assist at Mass with preparation for Eucharist. Must be a trained extraordinary communion minister to serve as a sacristan.

**Cantor** Vocalist who leads the congregation in song during Mass.

**Instrumentalist** Parishioners who play keyboard, guitar, or other instruments to accompany a cantor or choir for Mass.

**Praise Company Choir** Leads the congregation in music at the 9:00 AM Mass on the first and third Sunday of the month. Sings primarily contemporary hymns and Contemporary Christian Music Grade 9—adults.

**Ensembles** small groups of musicians who lead the congregation in song at Mass.

**Sound Technician** sets up and puts away microphones for choirs and ensembles. Runs the soundboard during Mass. Training offered.

**Altars Servers** Youth (from 4th grade) and adults who assist the presider at Mass.

**Funeral Altar Servers** Adult altar servers available on weekdays at Funeral Masses.

**Ushers** Teen & adult parishioners who assist in greeting and seating people, and taking up the collection.

**Greeters** Teens, adults, & families who welcome people as they enter church for Mass.

**Prayer Chain** Ministry in your home, praying for prayer requests.

**Eucharistic Adoration** Private prayer in our parish chapel before the Eucharist, currently offered throughout the day and night from Monday morning to Friday evening.

**Arts & Environment** Plans & assists with decorating the church, primarily at
